

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT between THE UNIVERSITY OF MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY, YANGON



and CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY

The University of Medical Technology, Yangon and Chiang Mai University by Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences implement this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of successful academic relations between the two Institutions. The purpose of this agreement is to promote academic and cultural exchange in the areas of education, research, and other activities, and have agreed to collaborate and work together towards the internationalization of higher education.

The areas of cooperation will include any programs offered by either institution which is felt to be desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of a cooperative relationship between the two institutions. However, any specific programs shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds, and approval of each institution. Such programs may include:

- a. Staff development
- b. Exchange of students
- c. Exchange of faculty members
- d. Joint research projects
- e. Joint conferences
- f. Joint cultural programs
- g. Other mutually beneficial projects which may be defined from time to time

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate responsible officers from both parties prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

This agreement shall be effective upon approval by both parties and shall remain in effect for an initial period of 5 years. Thereafter it shall be automatically renewed from year to year; however, after the initial period either institution may terminate the agreement by giving six months' prior written notice of such intent.

If any disagreement arises concerning with the MOA, it should be resolved harmoniously between the two institutions.
