

**COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT**  
**BETWEEN**  
**FACULTY OF ASSOCIATED MEDICAL SCIENCES,**  
**CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**  
**AND**  
**HEISEI REHABILITATION COLLEGE, JAPAN**

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This collaborative agreement was drawn up to indicate an academic collaborative agreement between Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences whose address is at 110 Inthawaroros Road, Sripoom District, Muang, Chiang Mai 50200, Thailand and Heisei Rehabilitation College having an address at Tsumon-Nishiguchi Cho 2-26, Nichinomiya-shi; 663-8231, Japan.

Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University, and Heisei Rehabilitation College hereby agree to promote student and staff exchanges between both institutions. The purpose of this agreement is to enhance the educational experience and cross-cultural understanding of students and faculty from both institutions. This agreement provides for exchange of opportunities for undergraduate students and both parties agree to institute this exchange program under the following terms:

1. Each party agrees to provide students and/or staff for exchange and shall accept students from the other party for exchange, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement.
2. Students will be selected by their Home Institution based on academic merit, language and suitability for study at the Host Institution.
3. The number of undergraduate students and staff exchanges for each institution participating in this program shall be approximately 2-6 persons per year.
4. The period of stay shall be a maximum of one week.
5. The Host Institution will endeavor to assure accommodation and living allowance for the exchange students.
6. The student will be responsible for the cost of transportation (airfares) to and from the Host Institution.
7. The agreement may at any time be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. It may be terminated within the period by either party giving six months notice to the other.


