



MEMORANDUM OF COLLABORATION

BETWEEN

YUNUS CENTER, ASIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY with its address at 42 km Paholyothin Hwy, Klong Luang, Pathumthani 12120, Thailand (hereinafter referred to as "YCA") of the first part;

AND

FACULTY OF ASSOCIATED MEDICAL SCIENCES, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY with its address at 110 Intawaroros Road, Sriproom, Muang, Chiang Mai, 50200 Thailand (hereinafter referred to as "**AMS CMU**") of the second part.

Following discussions between YCA and AMS CMU, the two institutions recognize the mutual benefits of establishing international collaborations by entering this Memorandum of Collaboration to promote mutual collaboration in research and academic between the two institutions through the following activities:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Collaboration is to develop research and academic collaborations on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote relations and mutual understanding between both institutions.

2. Scope of Cooperation

Both parties undertake to promote and develop academic collaborations which include but are not limited to the following:

- Exchange of academic and professional knowledge.
- Exchange of academic staff and students.
- Joint supervision of research students.
- Joint appointment of renowned professors.
- Collaboration in research and the promotion of research outputs; and
- Joint participation in nationally and internationally funded projects.

3. Arrangements of Implementation

- A. A detailed description of the collaboration, including financial arrangements, will be developed mutually for each specific case that will be subject to the review and approval processes of each party.
- B. The parties will ensure that all public statements including statements to the media or articles relating to the collaboration are cleared and consented by both prior to release and publication.
- C. Both parties will evaluate the collaboration before the end of this Memorandum of Collaboration.

4. Duration of Memorandum of Collaboration

This Memorandum of Collaboration will be effective upon signature by both parties. It will be in force for five [5] years and may be revised and/or renewed upon mutual consent. Either party may terminate this Memorandum of Collaboration by giving six [6] months prior written notice to the other party. Such termination shall not affect the validity and continuity of any incompletely discharged obligation agreed upon by the two parties before termination.
