MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

FACULTY OF ASSOCIATED MEDICAL SCIENCES, CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY

Chiang Mai University (Thailand), Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences and AIMST University (Malaysia), Faculty of Allied Health Professions implement this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of successful academic relations. The purpose of this agreement is to promote scientific relations through academic and research collaborations between both institutions.

- 1. Both institutions agree to promote and develop academic and research collaborations by the following means:
 - a. Exchange of students and staff members
 - b. Staff development
 - c. Visiting professorship
 - d. Execution of joint research projects
 - e. Provision of lectures and seminars
 - f. Exchange of data, documents, research materials and academic information
 - g. Other mutually beneficial projects which may be defined from time to time
- 2. Items pertaining to the implementation of the exchange programs based on this agreement shall be negotiated and agreed upon between both institutions for each specific program.
- 3. No commitment by either party of budget and financial support, however, is implied in this agreement.
- 4. This agreement may be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. It may also be terminated with in that period by either institution by giving the other institution not less than six months' notice of its intention to terminate it, without prejudice to complete of ongoing exchange programs.

- 5. This agreement will be effective from the date of signing for a period of five years. The agreement will be extended beyond that period after discussion by representatives of both institutions. The discussion can begin anytime before the final six months of this agreement.
- 6. This agreement is written in English, and each party will retain one copy each of the official text.
