



Memorandum of Co-operation Between

The Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences Chiang Mai University

And

Department of Virology I, Department of Bacteriology II, Department of Pathology,
Department of Immunology, Department of Veterinary Medicine,
Department of Mycobacteriology,
National Institute of Infectious Diseases

This Memorandum of Co-operation (MOC) is between:

The Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University, Thailand;

AND.

The Department of Virology I, the Department of Bacteriology II, the Department of Pathology, the Department of Immunology, the Department of Veterinary Science, and the Department of Mycobacteriology, National Institute of Infectious Diseases, Japan.

Hereinafter individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively referred to as the "Parties".

The Parties have hereby entered into this MOC to foster international co-operation in education and research that helps the Parties to extend and strengthen their scientific exchanges, to enhance mutual value, and to cultivate a better understanding among their people.

- 1. Both Parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular to promote international and academic cooperation as follows:
 - (1) Exchange of faculty members, research scholars, and students;
 - (2) Joint research activities and meetings on education and research:
 - (3) Exchange of materials and technologies in education and research, publications and academic information:
 - (4) Cooperation in graduate curricula.
 - These activities will focus on special topics as follows:
 - a) Biomedical Sciences;
 - b) Immunology, bacteriology, molecular biology, biochemistry, infectious and tropical diseases;
 - c) Pharmacology, vaccine development and developing techniques and diagnosis in infectious research and immunology.
- 2. This MOC shall be effective as of the date of signature by each Party. Any changes to the MOC including amendments or termination shall be effected after the Parties have reached a mutual agreement.
- 3. The Departments and the Faculty acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses arising out of this MOC including salary, travel and living costs, shall be the responsibility of each institute or university.
- 4. The parties agree that this MOC should be reviewed approximately every five years in order to evaluate the progress and to improve the quality of the exchange.
- 5. This MOC will be automatically terminated in the case of no activity for two consecutive years.
