ZAWACKA NAWA program 2025/2026

Key Points for Applicants:

1. Justification of Intent to Study/Research in Poland:

 Applicants must explain the reason for coming to Poland (whether it's for fulltime studies, research stays, or doctoral education) and describe how the experience will impact their future academic or professional career.

2. Application Attachments:

- For Full Cycle Studies (First, Second, or Unified Master's Programs):
 - A secondary school leaving certificate (for first-cycle applicants) or a copy of the diploma for second-cycle applicants.
 - For students in their final year of studies, a list of grades for the most recent semester.

o For Part-Time Studies:

- A copy of the diploma or transcript from previous studies.
- A CV (maximum 2 pages).
- Confirmation of admission to the program in Poland (or invitation).

For Doctoral Education or Research Stays:

- A copy of the highest degree obtained.
- A detailed CV (max 3 pages).
- Confirmation of admission to the doctoral program or research stay.

3. Language Requirements:

 Applicants must confirm their knowledge of Polish or a foreign language (depending on the language of instruction) at a level that enables communication at the host institution in Poland. A B2 level proficiency in the language of study must be demonstrated upon enrollment.

4. Scholarship Benefits:

- **o** Monthly Scholarship Rates:
 - Preparatory Course or Studies: PLN 1800 per month.
 - Doctoral Studies at Doctoral Schools:
 - PLN 3467 (before mid-term evaluation)
 - PLN 5341 (after mid-term evaluation).
 - **Research Stays**: PLN 2500 per month.
 - **Doctoral Degree Holders**: PLN 3500 per month.

- Coverage: The scholarship covers tuition fees for studies and preparatory courses at public universities, but research costs, conference participation, and materials are not covered.
- o **Insurance & Visa**: These are the responsibility of the recipient.

5. **Duration and Payment:**

- Scholarships are paid monthly, with specific durations based on the program:
 - **Preparatory Course**: Up to 10 months per academic year.
 - **Full-time Studies**: Paid for the statutory study period (typically up to 12 months per academic year).
 - **Research Stays**: Paid for a minimum of 15 days within a 30-day period to receive the full scholarship rate.

6. Additional Funding Conditions:

- **Tax Exemption**: The scholarship is exempt from income tax under Polish law.
- Non-eligibility for EU Erasmus+: The NAWA scholarship cannot be combined with the Erasmus+ grant.

7. Other Considerations:

Post-Completion Reports: Scholarship holders are required to submit final or annual reports based on the length of the stay, with the first report due upon completion of the preparatory course or first year of study.
