

ADDENDUM#1 TO MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING

Between

School of Health and Welfare, Jönköping University,

Kingdom of Sweden

And

Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Chiang Mai University,

Kingdom of Thailand

This document constitutes an Addendum to the agreement between Jönköping University and Chiang Mai University signed on July 4, 2017.

The objective of this Addendum is to describe the role and responsibilities of each party relative to the exchange of scholars, students, and academic information and materials between the parties.

1. Student exchanges

- 1.1 Students may be exchanged subject to the approval of the relevant course/program coordinator.
- 1.2 Students to be exchanged will be nominated by their home institution and.
 - 1.2.1 shall be in good academic standing and fluent in English.
 - 1.2.2 must have completed at least one year of undergraduate study or one semester of postgraduate study at their home institution.
 - 1.2.3 Students shall have an intention to enroll in subject that constitute full time study load (if applicable).
- 1.3 Students will be officially enrolled in their home institutions while they are on exchange.
- 1.4 Students on exchange will be required to abide by the rules and regulations of the host institution.
- 1.5 Students will have the same privileges provided to full-time students of the host institution while they are on exchange.

1.6 The host institution will provide "Letter of Acceptance" necessary for obtaining required visas.

2. Number of students and duration of exchanges

2.1 CMU will send up to 4 (four) students nominated by CMU for up to one academic semester.

2.2 JU will send up to 4 (four) students nominated by JU for up to one academic semester.

3. Tuition Fees

3.1 Students will pay regular tuition at their home institutions.

3.2 The host institution will provide waivers of tuition fees for the exchanged students. However, students may be required to pay transportation fee to fieldwork site, student's health fees and lab fees associated with specific courses.

3.3 Students will be responsible for the cost of traveling between Thailand and Sweden as well as the cost of immigration documents.

3.4 Exchange students will be required to provide proof of adequate health insurance coverage during their stay at host institutions.

4. Living costs and Accommodation

The host institution will assist in the arrangement of accommodation for the exchange students by providing information on housing alternatives. The host institution is not obligated, financially or otherwise, to provide housing. All living and accommodation costs are to be paid by the students.

5. Reception and orientation

Each institution will ensure that adequate arrangements are made for the reception and orientation of exchange students.

6. Transmission of results

Official transcripts of results for each exchange student will be provided to the nominated office at each institution.

7. Validity

The agreement duration will be equivalent to the durations of the Memorandum of Understanding between universities.


All terms and provisions from the original MOU also apply to this Addendum.
