

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between  
**The Faculty of Health and Social Sciences,  
The Hong Kong Polytechnic University**

And

**The Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences,  
Chiang Mai University**

The Faculty of Health and Social Sciences (FHSS), The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) of the People's Republic of China, and The Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences (AMS), Chiang Mai University (CMU) of Thailand, considering their common interest in promoting the mutual collaboration in the area of education and research, have set forth the following Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):

### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to develop academic and educational collaborations on the basis of equality and reciprocity and to promote relations and mutual understanding between both universities.

### 2. Scope of Cooperation

Both parties undertake to promote and develop academic collaborations which include but are not limited to the following:

- Exchange of academic and professional knowledge.
- Exchange of academic staff and students;
- Joint supervision of research students;
- Joint appointment of renowned professors;
- Collaboration in research and the promotion of research outputs; and
- Joint participation in internationally funded projects.

### 3. Arrangements of Implementation

- i) A detailed description of the collaboration, including financial arrangements, will be developed mutually for each specific case that will be subject to the review and approval processes of each party.
- ii) The parties will ensure that all public statements including statements to the media or articles relating to the collaboration are cleared and consented by both prior to release or publication.
- iii) Both parties will evaluate the collaboration on a yearly basis.
- iv) Both parties agree to designate the following persons as the local representatives for the coordination of the collaboration:


#### 4. Duration of MOU

Either party may terminate this MOU by giving a six-month prior written notice to the other party. Such termination shall not affect the validity and continuity of any incompletely discharged obligation agreed upon by the two parties before termination.

The headings and captions of this MOU are inserted for convenience of reference and do not define, limit or describe the scope or intent of this MOU or any particular section, paragraph, or provision.






